Paragraph Version of Curriculum: The MPH in Health Behavior and Health Promotion requires a total of 45 credit hours of which 36 credit hours will be didactic coursework, including fifteen credit hours in five core courses required by the Council of Education for Public Health: biostatistics, epidemiology, environmental health science, health systems and policy, and social and behavioral sciences. Students will be required to fulfill 6 credit hours of health behavior and health promotion coursework in addition to the core social sciences and behavioral course, a 2 hour introduction to public health course, one semester of a 1 hour public health seminar course, a 1 hour course in inter-professional team skills, and 6 hours of non-specified elective courses. During their second year, students will complete an internship (for 6 credit hours) and demonstrate their knowledge in a capstone project (3 credit hours).

Bulleted Version of Curriculum: The MPH in Health Behavior and Health Promotion requires a total of 45 credit hours of which 36 credit hours will be didactic coursework, including

- 15 credit hours in five core courses required by the Council of Education for Public Health: biostatistics, epidemiology, environmental health science, health systems and policy, and social and behavioral sciences
- 6 credit hours of health behavior and health promotion coursework in addition to the core social sciences and behavioral course
- 2 credit hours in the introduction to public health course
- 1 semester of a 1 credit hour in the public health seminar course
- 1 semester of a 1 credit inter-professional course
- 6 credit hours of non-specified elective courses.

During their second year, students will complete an internship (for 6 credit hours) and demonstrate their knowledge in a capstone project (3 credit hours).
