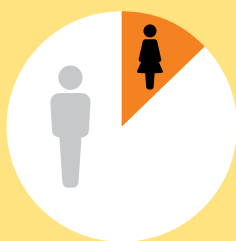


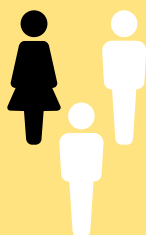

KEY DATES

- Applications accepted through August 1, 2023
- Notification of acceptance by September 2023
- Program begins in September 2023



ELIGIBILITY

- Women faculty (rank of Associate Professor or below) & senior postdoctoral fellows
- Full-time position college or university in South Carolina or other NIH IDeA State
- All levels of entrepreneurial experience



COSTS

- Costs associated with the program including course fees and coaching sessions are provided by funding from the NIGMS

APPLICATION MATERIALS

- Applicant statement of interest letter
- Applicant NIH style biographical sketch or similar document, limited to 5 pages
- Letter of commitment from the Applicant's department chair/chief confirming the applicant will have required time
- Signed agreement from the applicant committing to participate in all program activities and to complete the program
