

Panopto: Preparing Your Moodle Course

To begin using Panopto with your Moodle Course you'll need to follow the instructions below for Provisioning the course.

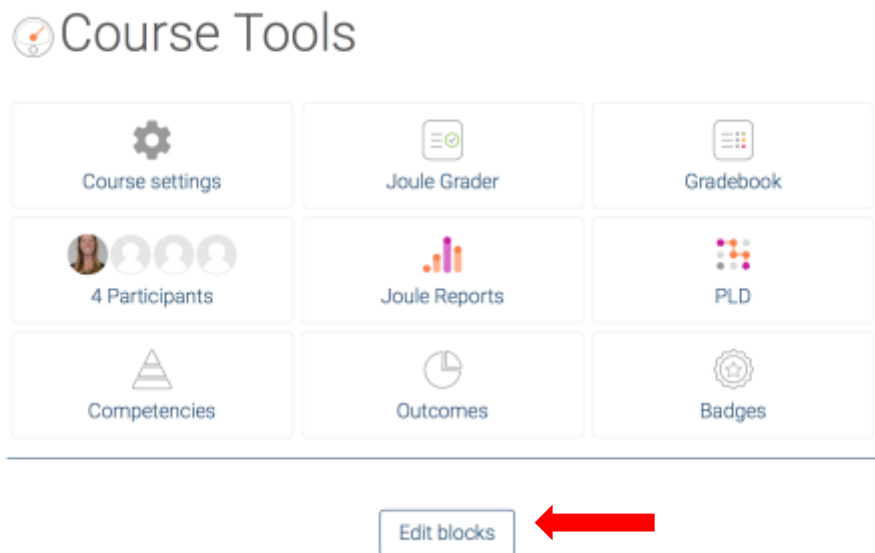
NOTE: You must provision each course in Moodle to link video content hosted in Panopto.

Adding the Panopto Block

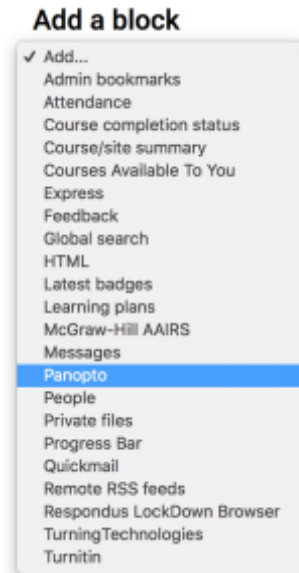
1. Navigate to the Moodle course you want to link to Panopto.
2. Select the Course Tools button below the module navigation.



3. Select Edit Blocks.



4. Go to Add a Block drop-down menu. Select Panopto from the alphabetical list.



6. You will now see the block added to your course. Simply adding the block to your course does not create a folder in Panopto for this. Follow the directions in the next section to link your course to Panopto.

1. Once you have added the block to your course, select Provision Course in the block.



2. Once you have added the block to your course, select Provision Course in the block.
3. If provisioning was successful, you will see a success message on a new page. The page will list those as teachers in the course which will be creators in the Panopto folder, and those as students which will be viewers in the Panopto folder.
4. This will update the block in the Moodle course. Everyone can see any live sessions being recorded and be able to join them, a list of the completed recordings, and any podcast feeds. As a teacher you are able to see a link for the course settings taking you right to the course settings pop-up box in Panopto, as well as a link to download the Panopto recorder for Windows or Mac.
