

MUSC Student Health Services Pre-Matriculation Requirements

Requirement	Document required
Tuberculosis screening (within 3 months of start of school)	QuantiFERON Blood Test or T-Spot Blood Test (blood tests are preferred)
	<u>OR</u>
	2 TB skin tests(also called PPDs) 1-3 weeks apart (placement and reading with results for both)
Rubeola/Red Measles (MMR vaccines)	Lab Report of Rubeola (Measles) IgG Quantitative Titer demonstrating immunity to Rubeola/Measles
	<u>OR</u>
	Date of dose #1 must be on or after 1st birthday AND after 12/31/67 Date of dose #2 at least 30 days after dose #1
Mumps (MMR vaccines)	Lab Report of Mumps IgG Quantitative Titer demonstrating immunity
	<u>OR</u>
	Date of dose #1 must be on or after 1st birthday AND after 12/31/67 Date of dose #2 at least 30 days after dose#1
Rubella/German Measles (MMR vaccines)	Lab Report of Rubella IgG Quantitative Titer demonstrating immunity
	<u>OR</u>
	Date of dose #1 must be on or after 1st birthday Date of dose #2 at least 30 days after 1st dose
Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Adult Tdap)	An adult Tdap on or after 6/10/2005. If your Adult Tdap is greater than 10 years old you will need to show proof of current Td or Tdap vaccine
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Lab Report of Varicella IgG Quantitative titer demonstrating immunity to Varicella
	<u>OR</u>
	Date of dose #1 Varivax/Chicken Pox vaccine after 03/17/1995
	Date of dose #2 Varivax/Chicken Pox vaccine given 28 days after dose #1 <i>*Documented Chicken Pox Disease is not accepted as immunity.</i>
Flu Vaccine	Due to the nature of the flu vaccine, requirement and deadline depend on enrollment term.
	Spring Enrollment (January): Required upon entry
	Summer Enrollment (May-July): Requirement deferred until September
	Fall Enrollment (August): Current Flu shot available in September

Covid-19	Date(s) of Primary Series (2 doses of Pfizer/ Moderna, 1 dose of J& J) Date of booster dose
	*Accepted MUSC Covid Vaccines: Pfizer, Moderna, Janssen (Johnson and Johnson)
Meningococcal Vaccines accepted: Menactra, Meneveo, Menomune or Unknown	Signed Meningococcal Form online at LifeNet.misc.edu <i>*If you have had a meningococcal vaccine please indicate that on the required form on LifeNet and enter the dates you received the vaccine in the Meningococcal line under "Medical Clearances"</i>
Hepatitis B vaccine series- Engerix -3 series given 0M,1M & 6M or Hepilisav -2 series given 0M and 1M	Copy of original documentation of Hepatitis B series (series usually peds/adol)
Hepatitis B IgG Surface Antibody Quantitative Titer	Lab Report of Hepatitis B IgG Surface Antibody Quantitative titer demonstrating Immunity <i>NOTE: All Clinical MUSC students are required to show Immunity to Hepatitis B</i>

IF YOUR HEP B TITER RESULTS ARE:

Non-immune (negative for antibodies)	Will need Hep B booster, followed by a repeat titer(1 month after booster) to check immunity after booster
Immunity detected (postive for antibodies)	No further action required
